Program Overview

- Wilderness-based residential program
- Short-term (2 months)
- Rehabilitative skills development for youth ages 12-18
- 9 youth and 3 staff per group



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Who We Serve

- Alaskan youth who meet criteria for an SED (Severe Emotional Disturbance) diagnosis
- Examples of issues: Depression, impulsivity, attachment issues, anxiety, anger, rebellion/defiance, failing in school, legal issues, abusing alcohol and drugs

Our Approach

- Strength-based program
- Trauma-informed staff
- Wilderness-based experiential model



Referrals and Enrollment

- Parents and professionals may refer
- Admission offered April through November
- Initial screening and assessment interview by phone
